- AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to establishing a peer support program for veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 2 7.42 to read as follows:

3 S 7.42 PEER SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR VETERANS.

4 THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION THE TERM "PEER SUPPORT SERVICES" (A) FOR 5 SHALL MEAN ANY SERVICE DESIGNATED BY THE OFFICE USED IN THE TREATMENT 6 AND RECOVERY OF MENTAL ILLNESS, ALCOHOL ABUSE, SUBSTANCE ABUSE, AND/OR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCE THAT IS DELIVERED BY A CERTIFIED PEER COUNSELOR; AND 7 8 THE TERM "CERTIFIED PEER COUNSELOR" SHALL MEAN AN INDIVIDUAL, WHO HAS 9 APPLIED TO AND BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE OFFICE, WITH PERSONAL EXPERIENCE AS 10 MENTAL HEALTH RECIPIENT AND/OR AN INDIVIDUAL IN RECOVERY FROM ALCOHOL А 11 ABUSE, SUBSTANCE ABUSE, AND/OR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCE, WHO HAS SERVED IN ACTIVE MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES AND HAS BEEN 12 THE 13 RELEASED FROM SUCH SERVICE OTHERWISE THAN BY DISHONORABLE DISCHARGE AND DOCUMENTED BY HIS OR HER DISCHARGE PAPERS OR WHO HAS BEEN FURLOUGHED 14 AS 15 TO THE RESERVE COMPONENTS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO HAS TRAINING, CREDENTIALS OR EXPERIENCE RECOGNIZED BY THE OFFICE. 16

OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE 17 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY (B) 18 COMMISSIONER, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF ALCOHOLISM AND 19 ABUSE SERVICES, AND THE STATE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF SUBSTANCE 20 VETERANS' AFFAIRS SHALL DEVELOP AND ESTABLISH A MINIMUM OF TWO REGIONAL 21 SERVICES PROGRAMS FOR VETERANS. SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE PEER SUPPORT

PEER SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, PEER
 COUNSELING FOR MENTAL ILLNESS INCLUDING POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER,
 ALCOHOL AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING, INFORMATION ON ACCESS TO
 SERVICES, FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES, AND WHERE APPLICABLE, SPECIALIZED
 SERVICES FOR FEMALE VETERANS.

6 (C) THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF THE 7 OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES AND THE STATE DIRECTOR 8 OF THE DIVISION OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS SHALL FOSTER PROGRAMS FOR THE 9 TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT OF PERSONS CAPABLE OF PROVIDING THE SERVICES 10 SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A PROCESS OF 11 ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR AND ISSUING CREDENTIALS FOR CERTIFIED PEER 12 COUNSELORS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING:

13 1. THE OFFICE SHALL ESTABLISH MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR CERTIFIED 14 PEER COUNSELORS IN ALL PHASES OF DELIVERY OF SERVICES TO VETERANS WHO 15 ARE SUFFERING FROM ANY OR A COMBINATION OF THE FOLLOWING: MENTAL 16 ILLNESS, ALCOHOL ABUSE, SUBSTANCE ABUSE, AND/OR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCE THAT 17 SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, COMPLETION OF APPROVED COURSES OF 18 STUDY OR EQUIVALENT ON-THE-JOB EXPERIENCE IN MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING 19 AND/OR ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING; AND

20 2. THE OFFICE SHALL ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS 21 FOR AND ISSUING CREDENTIALS TO CERTIFIED PEER COUNSELORS WHO MEET MINI-22 MUM QUALIFICATIONS, AND SHALL FURTHER ESTABLISH PROCEDURES TO SUSPEND, 23 REVOKE, OR ANNUL SUCH CREDENTIALS FOR GOOD CAUSE.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
