AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to the release of child protective services records in the event of kidnapping

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 424-c to read as follows:
 - S 424-C. RELEASE OF RECORDS IN THE EVENT OF KIDNAPPING. THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES SHALL, UPON RECEIPT OF A REPORTED KIDNAPPING FROM A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, RELEASE TO SUCH AGENCY ALL REPORTS AND RECORDS FILED PURSUANT TO THIS TITLE.
- 7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
