AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting dangerous wheels

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 375 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 35-b to read as follows:

- 35-B. USE OF DANGEROUS WHEELS PROHIBITED. (A) NO PERSON SHALL DRIVE UPON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY A MOTOR VEHICLE, TRAILER, OR SEMI-TRAILER THAT IS EQUIPPED WITH DANGEROUS WHEELS.
- (B) ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL FOR A FIRST CONVICTION THEREOF BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF UP TO TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS; FOR A CONVICTION OF A SECOND VIOLATION, BOTH OF WHICH WERE COMMITTED WITHIN A PERIOD OF EIGHTEEN MONTHS, SUCH PERSON SHALL BE GUILTY OF A TRAFFIC INFRACTION AND SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND NOT MORE THAN THREE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS; UPON CONVICTION OF A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, ALL OF WHICH WERE COMMITTED WITHIN A PERIOD OF EIGHTEEN MONTHS, SUCH PERSON SHALL BE GUILTY OF A TRAFFIC INFRACTION AND SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN THREE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND NOT MORE THAN SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS.
- (C) AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, "DANGEROUS WHEELS" MEANS ANY WHEEL, WHEEL COVER, HUBCAP, LUG NUT OR LUG CAP, LUG NUT COVERS, WHEEL STUD COVERS, PRONGS, BLADES, SPIKES, OR ANY OTHER PROJECTION OR ANY PART AFFIXED TO ANY OF THE AFOREMENTIONED ITEMS THAT:
- 21 (I) IS MODIFIED FROM THE ORIGINAL VEHICLE MANUFACTURER'S STANDARD PART 22 FOR THE VEHICLE ON WHICH IT IS INSTALLED, IS SUBSTITUTED WITH A NON-ORI-23 GINAL AFTERMARKET PART, OR TO WHICH AFTERMARKET PARTS ARE ADDED TO THE 24 MANUFACTURER'S OTHERWISE STANDARD WHEELS OR COVERS; AND

(II) EXTENDS TWO INCHES OR MORE BEYOND THE SURFACE OF THE WHEEL RIM OR EXTENDS BEYOND THE BODY OF THE VEHICLE WHEN VIEWED FROM DIRECTLY ABOVE.
