AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to establishing a commission on improving education in state prisons

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The correction law is amended by adding a new section 49 to 2
- read as follows: 3 49. COMMISSION ON PRISON EDUCATION. THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED A
  - COMMISSION ON PRISON EDUCATION COMPRISED OF NINE MEMBERS WHO SHALL STUDY AND DEVELOP A PLAN FOR IMPROVING EDUCATION IN THE STATE PRISON
- 6 COMMISSION ON PRISON EDUCATION SHALL CONSIDER AND INVESTIGATE THE
- 7 FOLLOWING FACTORS WHEN DETERMINING EDUCATION IMPROVEMENTS: THE IMPACT ON
- AN INMATE'S EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES UPON RELEASE FROM PRISON,
- IMPACT ON AN INMATE'S REINTEGRATION INTO SOCIETY AND THE EFFECTIVENESS 9 IN REDUCING RECIDIVISM. APPOINTMENTS TO THE TASK FORCE SHALL BE MADE AS 10
- FOLLOWS: THREE BY THE GOVERNOR; TWO BY THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY; ONE 11
- BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE ASSEMBLY; TWO BY THE 12 TEMPORARY
- THE SENATE AND ONE BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE. THE COMMIS-13
- SION ON PRISON EDUCATION SHALL ISSUE A REPORT WITHIN TEN MONTHS AFTER 14
- THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION. 15
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
