- AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to issuance of driver's licenses and emergency medical personnel designation; and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as separately amended by chapters 465 and 487 of the laws of 2012, is REPEALED and a new subdivision 1 is added to read as follows:

4 APPLICATION FOR LICENSE. APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE SHALL 1. 5 BE MADE TO THE COMMISSIONER. THE FEE PRESCRIBED BY LAW MAY BE SUBMITTED б WITH SUCH APPLICATION. THE APPLICANT SHALL FURNISH SUCH PROOF OF IDENTI-7 TY, AGE, AND FITNESS AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSIONER. ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF IDENTITY SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO FOREIGN PASSPORTS 8 9 (VISA STAMPS ARE NOT REQUIRED), VALID DOCUMENTATION ISSUED BY USCIS AND CONSULAR IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS. ELIGIBILITY FOR A DRIVERS' 10 LICENSE 11 SHALL NOT BE CONDITIONED ON A PARTICULAR IMMIGRATION STATUS. THE COMMIS-SIONER MAY ALSO PROVIDE THAT THE APPLICATION PROCEDURE SHALL INCLUDE THE 12 A PHOTO IMAGE OR IMAGES OF THE APPLICANT IN ACCORDANCE WITH 13 TAKING OF 14 RULES AND REGULATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER. IN ADDITION, THE 15 COMMISSIONER ALSO SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE APPLICANT PROVIDE HIS OR HER 16 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER WHERE SUCH APPLICANT IS A LEGAL IMMIGRANT, OR 17 INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (ITIN) OR A LETTER OR FORM FROM THE UNITED STATES SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION THAT 18 STATES THAT NOT ELIGIBLE OR SUBMIT A SWORN STATEMENT UNDER THE 19 APPLICANT IS THE 20 PENALTY OF PERJURY, STATING THAT THE APPLICANT DOES NOT HAVE Α SOCIAL 21 SECURITY NUMBER OR ITIN, AND SHALL PROVIDE SPACE ON THE APPLICATION SO 22 THAT THE APPLICANT MAY REGISTER IN THE NEW YORK STATE ORGAN AND TISSUE

1 DONOR REGISTRY UNDER SECTION FORTY-THREE HUNDRED TEN OF THE PUBLIC 2 HEALTH LAW WITH THE FOLLOWING STATED ON THE APPLICATION IN CLEAR AND 3 CONSPICUOUS TYPE:

4 "YOU MUST FILL OUT THE FOLLOWING SECTION: WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE ADDED 5 TO THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY? CHECK BOX FOR 'YES' OR 'SKIP THIS QUES-6 TION'."

7 THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL NOT MAINTAIN 8 RECORDS OF ANY PERSON WHO CHECKS "SKIP THIS QUESTION". FAILURE TO CHECK BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR THE VALIDITY OF AN APPLICATION, AND FAILURE TO 9 А 10 CHECK "YES" OR CHECKING "SKIP THIS QUESTION" SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED ТΟ WISH NOT TO DONATE. IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT UNDER EIGHTEEN 11 IMPLY A 12 YEARS OF AGE, CHECKING "YES" SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE CONSENT ТО MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGISTRATION IN THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY. WHERE AN 13 14 APPLICANT HAS PREVIOUSLY CONSENTED TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGIS-TERED IN 15 THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY, CHECKING "SKIP THIS QUESTION" OR 16 FAILING TO CHECK A BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR THAT CONSENT OR REGISTRATION. IN 17 ADDITION, THE COMMISSIONER ALSO SHALL REQUIRE THAT SPACE SHALL ΒE 18 PROVIDED ON THE APPLICATION SO THAT THE APPLICANT MAY REQUEST A NOTATION 19 UPON SUCH LICENSE THAT HE OR SHE IS A VETERAN OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED 20 FORCES AND SPACE SO THAT THE APPLICANT MAY REQUEST A NOTATION UPON SUCH 21 LICENSE THAT HE OR SHE IS AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL. ADDITION, IN 22 A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE WHO WILL OPERATE A AN APPLICANT FOR 23 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IN INTERSTATE COMMERCE SHALL CERTIFY THAT SUCH 24 APPLICANT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS TO OPERATE A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE, 25 AS SET FORTH IN PUBLIC LAW 99-570, TITLE XII, AND TITLE 49 OF THECODE 26 OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS, AND ALL REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE UNITED 27 STATES SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION UNDER THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TRANS-28 ADDITION, AN APPLICANT FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S PORTATION ACT. IN LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AT SUCH INTERVALS AS REQUIRED 29 BY THE FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 30 1999 AND PART 49 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS RELATING TO 31 383.71(H) OF TITLE32 MEDICAL CERTIFICATION AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THECOMMISSIONER. 33 SECTION AND SECTIONS FIVE HUNDRED THREE, FIVE FOR PURPOSES OF THIS 34 HUNDRED TEN-A, AND FIVE HUNDRED TEN-AA OF THIS TITLE, THE TERMS "MEDICAL CERTIFICATE" AND "MEDICAL CERTIFICATION" SHALL MEAN A FORM SUBSTANTIALLY 35 IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE FORM SET FORTH IN PART 391.43(H) OF TITLE 36 49 OF 37 THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS. UPON A DETERMINATION THAT THE HOLDER OF 38 A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE HAS MADE ANY FALSE STATEMENT, WITH RESPECT 39 TO THE APPLICATION FOR SUCH LICENSE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REVOKE SUCH 40 LICENSE.

41 S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 42 added by section one of this act, is amended to read as follows:

43 Application for license. Application for a driver's license shall 1. 44 be made to the commissioner. The fee prescribed by law may be submitted 45 with such application. The applicant shall furnish such proof of identity, age, and fitness as may be required by the commissioner. Acceptable 46 47 proof of identity shall include, but not be limited to foreign passports 48 (visa stamps are not required), valid documentation issued by USCIS and 49 consular identification documents. Eligibility for a drivers' license 50 shall not be conditioned on a particular immigration status. The 51 commissioner may also provide that the application procedure shall include the taking of a photo image or images of the applicant in 52 accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner. In 53 54 addition, the commissioner also shall require that the applicant provide 55 his or her social security number where such applicant is a legal immi-56 grant, or individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN) or a letter

1 or form from the United States social security administration that 2 states that the applicant is not eligible or submit a sworn statement 3 under the penalty of perjury, stating that the applicant does not have a 4 social security number of ITIN, and [shall] provide space on the appli-5 cation so that the applicant may register in the New York state organ 6 and tissue donor registry under section forty-three hundred ten of the 7 public health law [with the following stated on the application in clear 8 and conspicuous type:

9 "You must fill out the following section: Would you like to be added 10 to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this ques-11 tion'."

The commissioner of the department of health shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check 12 13 14 a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to 15 check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to 16 imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under eighteen 17 years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an 18 anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. When an 19 applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" 20 or 21 failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration]. In addition, the commissioner also shall require that space shall be 22 23 provided on the application so that the applicant may request a notation 24 upon such license that he or she is a veteran of the United States armed 25 forces and space so that the applicant may request a notation upon such 26 license that he or she is an emergency medical personnel. In addition, applicant for a commercial driver's license who will operate a 27 an commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce shall certify that 28 such 29 applicant meets the requirements to operate a commercial motor vehicle, as set forth in public law 99-570, title XII, and title 49 of the code 30 federal regulations, and all regulations promulgated by the United 31 of States secretary of transportation under the hazardous materials trans-32 33 portation act. In addition, an applicant for a commercial driver's license shall submit a medical certificate at such intervals as required 34 35 by the federal motor carrier safety improvement act of 1999 and Part 383.71(h) of title 49 of the code of federal regulations relating to 36 37 medical certification and in a manner prescribed by the commissioner. 38 For purposes of this section and sections five hundred three, five hundred ten-a, and five hundred ten-aa of this title, the terms "medical 39 40 certificate" and "medical certification" shall mean a form substantially in compliance with the form set forth in Part 391.43(h) of title 49 of 41 the code of federal regulations. Upon a determination that the holder of 42 43 a commercial driver's license has made any false statement, with respect 44 to the application for such license, the commissioner shall revoke such 45 license.

46 S 3. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 6 of section 502 of the vehicle and 47 traffic law, as amended by section 3 of part K of chapter 59 of the laws 48 of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

49 (a) A license issued pursuant to subdivision five of this section 50 shall be valid until the expiration date contained thereon, unless such license is suspended, revoked or cancelled. Such license may be renewed 51 by submission of an application for renewal, the fee prescribed by 52 law, proofs of prior licensing, fitness and acceptable vision prescribed by 53 54 the commissioner, the applicant's social security number, OR INDIVIDUAL 55 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (ITIN) OR A LETTER OR FORM FROM THE TAXPAYER 56 UNITED STATES SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION THAT STATES THAT THE APPLI-

CANT IS NOT ELIGIBLE OR SUBMIT A SWORN STATEMENT UNDER THE PENALTY OF 1 2 THE APPLICANT DOES NOT HAVE A SOCIAL SECURITY PERJURY, STATING THAT 3 NUMBER OR ITIN, and if required by the commissioner a photo image of the 4 applicant in such numbers and form as the commissioner shall prescribe. 5 In addition, an applicant for renewal of a license containing a hazard-6 material endorsement shall pass an examination to retain such ous 7 endorsement. The commissioner shall, with respect to the renewal of a 8 hazardous materials endorsement, comply with the requirements imposed upon states by sections 383.141 and 1572.13 of title 49 of the code of 9 10 federal regulations. A renewal of such license shall be issued by the commissioner upon approval of such application, except that no such 11 12 license shall be issued if its issuance would be inconsistent with the 13 provisions of section five hundred sixteen of this title, and except 14 that the commissioner may refuse to renew such license if the applicant 15 is the holder of a currently valid or renewable license to drive issued 16 by another state or foreign country unless the applicant surrenders such 17 license.

18 S 4. Subdivision 1 of section 504 of the vehicle and traffic law is 19 amended by adding a new paragraph (a-2) to read as follows:

(A-2) EVERY LICENSE OR RENEWAL THEREOF ISSUED TO AN APPLICANT 20 WHO IS EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL, UPON HIS OR HER REQUEST AND SUBMISSION 21 AN 22 OF PROOF AS SET FORTH HEREIN, CONTAIN A DISTINGUISHING MARK, INSUCH 23 FORM AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DETERMINE, INDICATING THAT HE OR SHE IS AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL. SUCH PROOF SHALL CONSIST OF ANY 24 PROOF 25 SATISFACTORY TO THE COMMISSIONER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT REQUIRE 26 FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH LICENSES OR RENEWALS THEREOF TO PERSONS REQUESTING AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL NOTATION WHICH IS DIFFERENT 27 28 FROM FEES OTHERWISE REQUIRED.

29 S 5. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 30 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that section two of this 31 act shall take effect October 3, 2017.
