AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to the performance of a study regarding homeless persons who are veterans in the state of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 14 of the public housing law is amended by adding a new paragraph (q) to read as follows:

TO CONDUCT A STUDY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE, DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, AND OFFICE OF AND FAMILY SERVICES TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF HOMELESS PERSONS IN NEW YORK STATE THAT ARE VETERANS. SUCH STUDY SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: (I) AN ANALYSIS OF VETERANS IN NEW YORK STATE WHO ARE CURRENTLY HOMELESS, OR HAVE BEEN HOMELESS WITHIN FIVE YEARS OF RELEASED FROM ACTIVE DUTY INCLUDING AN ANALYSIS OF GENDER AS IT RELATES TO HOMELESSNESS OF VETERANS; (II) DATA ON THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN CURRENT PLACEMENT OF SUCH CHILDREN; HOMELESS VETERANS, INCLUDING THE(III) CASES OF MILITARY SEXUAL TRAUMA EXPERIENCED BY HOMELESS WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY OR DURING MILITARY TRAINING, INCLUDING A BREAKDOWN OF THE COLLECTED DATA BASED UPON THE GENDER OF THE VICTIM; AND (IV) UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FOR NEW YORK STATE VETERANS.
