AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to the performance of a study regarding homeless persons who are veterans in the state of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 14 of the public housing law is amended by adding a new paragraph (q) to read as follows:

(Q) TO CONDUCT A STUDY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE, DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, AND OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF HOMELESS PERSONS YORK STATE THAT ARE VETERANS. SUCH STUDY SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO: (I) AN ANALYSIS OF VETERANS IN NEW YORK STATE WHO CURRENTLY HOMELESS, OR HAVE BEEN HOMELESS WITHIN FIVE YEARS OF BEING RELEASED FROM ACTIVE DUTY INCLUDING AN ANALYSIS OF GENDER AS IT HOMELESSNESS OF DATA ON THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN OF **VETERANS**; (II) HOMELESS VETERANS, INCLUDING THE CURRENT PLACEMENT OF SUCH CHILDREN; AND (III) THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FOR NEW YORK STATE VETERANS. THE TERM "CHIL-DREN OF HOMELESS VETERANS" SHALL MEAN A PERSON WHO IS UNMARRIED AND AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS, AND IS THE BIOLOGICAL OR LEGALLY ADOPTED CHILD OF A VETERAN. A WRITTEN REPORT OF SUCH STUDY
