AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to banning formaldehyde in certain children's products

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Article 37 of the environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new title 9 to read as follows:

TITLE IX

FORMALDEHYDE PROHIBITION

1. DEFINITIONS. (A) "CHILDREN'S PRODUCT" MEANS A PRODUCT PRIMARILY INTENDED OR MARKETED BY A MANUFACTURER TO BE PHYSICALLY DESIGNED, APPLIED TO OR INTRODUCED INTO A CHILD'S BODY, OR USED BY A PRODUCTS, TOYS, CAR SEATS, PERSONAL CARE PRODUCTS, A PRODUCT DESIGNED OR INTENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER TO HELP A CHILD WITH SUCKING OR TEETHING, TO FACILITATE SLEEP, RELAXATION, OR THE FEEDING OF NOVELTY PRODUCTS, BEDDING, FURNITURE, FURNISHINGS, AND CHILDREN'S "CHILDREN'S PRODUCT" DOES NOT INCLUDE (I) BATTERIES; APPAREL. OR PRODUCTS CONSUMER ELECTRONIC INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PERSONAL COMPUTERS, AUDIO AND VIDEO EQUIPMENT, CALCULATORS, WIRELESS PHONES, GAME SCREEN, CONSOLES, AND HANDHELD DEVICES INCORPORATING A VIDEO USED ACCESS INTERACTIVE SOFTWARE AND THEIR ASSOCIATED PERIPHERALS; OR (III) A BEVERAGE OR AN ADDITIVE TO A FOOD OR BEVERAGE REGULATED BY THE FOOD OR UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION; OR (IV) A PESTICIDE

- 2. FORMALDEHYDE IN CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS; BAN. BEGINNING APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND EIGHTEEN, NO RETAILER MAY SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE IN THIS STATE A CHILDREN'S PRODUCT THAT INTENTIONALLY CONTAINS: (A) FORMALDEH-9 YDE, INCLUDING FORMALDEHYDE CONTAINED IN A SOLUTION; OR
- 10 (B) INGREDIENTS THAT CHEMICALLY DEGRADE UNDER NORMAL CONDITIONS OF 11 TEMPERATURE AND PRESSURE TO RELEASE FREE FORMALDEHYDE AT LEVELS EXCEED-12 ING 0.05 PERCENT.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-14 ing the date upon which it shall have become a law.
