AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to authorizing the town of Deerfield in Oneida county to transfer jurisdiction of a road to the state

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 31 of section 341 of the highway law is amended by adding a new paragraph 6 to read as follows:

- EFFECTIVE APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD IN THE COUNTY OF ONEIDA, HAVING PREVIOUSLY APPROVED THE ABANDONMENT OF CERTAIN TOWN ROADS, AS SET FORTH IN THIS SUBDIVISION, THE COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED TO ASSUME JURISDICTION FOR THE PURPOSES OVER ROAD IDENTIFIED AS THE SOUTH-BOUND HIGHWAY SERVICE ROAD AND ASSOCIATED RAMP SECTIONS BUILT UNDER NEW YORK DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT D250071 IN NINETEEN HUNDRED EIGHT-Y-TWO PARALLEL TO STATE ROUTE EIGHT AND TWELVE FROM THE CITY OF UTICA LINE NORTH TO THE MULANEY ROAD INTERCHANGE, INCLUDING ANY PAVEMENT, SHOULDER AREA, DRAINAGE SYSTEM, LANDSCAPING, CURBS, AND LOCATED THEREON OR IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT THERETO.
- S 2. The commissioner of transportation and the town of Deerfield are authorized to permanently close such portions of the highway transferred to the state as necessary to eliminate travel over sections of the highway that are unfit or unnecessary for travel due to flooding or erosion, provided, however, that provision is made for the access to or acquisition of any properties that would be denied access to public highways due to such closure.
- S 3. This transfer of jurisdiction shall be deemed to transfer all right, title and interest of the town of Deerfield in the transferred highways to the state. Furthermore, the state acquisition of such property pursuant to this act shall be deemed to be an acquisition pursuant to section 30 of the highway law for all subsequent purposes and uses.

S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
