AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to enacting the "state workforce injury reduction act"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "state workforce injury reduction act".

 - S 2. Section 7 of the civil service law is amended by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:
 - 7. EACH STATE AGENCY REFERENCED IN THE ANNUAL REPORT ISSUED BY THE PRESIDENT PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX OF THIS SECTION SHALL WITHIN NINE-TY DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF SUCH REPORT SUBMIT TO THE PRESIDENT A WRITTEN ACTION PLAN FOR REDUCING OCCURRENCES OF SUCH INJURIES IN THE COMING YEAR. UPON RECEIPT OF SUCH ACTION PLAN BUT NO LATER THAN ONE HUNDRED TWENTY DAYS AFTER ISSUING THE REPORT PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX OF THIS SECTION, THE PRESIDENT SHALL ISSUE AN ADDENDUM TO THE REPORT WITH A SUMMARY OF ALL OF THE ACTION PLANS SUBMITTED BY EACH AFFECTED STATE
