AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to authorizing a tax check-off for the state library system

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 630-e to 2 read as follows:
- 3 S 630-E. GIFTS FOR THE STATE LIBRARY SYSTEM. EFFECTIVE FOR ANY TAX 4 YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN, AN 5 INDIVIDUAL IN ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE STATE
- 6 LIBRARY AID PROGRAM FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PUBLIC LIBRARIES AND 7 LIBRARY SYSTEMS, REFERENCE AND RESEARCH LIBRARY RESOURCE SYSTEMS, THE
- 8 NEW YORK PUBLIC RESEARCH LIBRARIES, THE SCHOMBURG COLLECTION AND THE 9 LIBRARY FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY HANDICAPPED. SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL
- 10 BE IN ANY WHOLE DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE
- 11 TAX OWED BY SUCH INDIVIDUAL. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE
- 12 PERSONAL INCOME TAX RETURN TO ENABLE A TAXPAYER TO MAKE SUCH CONTRIB-13 UTION. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW ALL REVENUES
- 13 UTION. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW ALL REVENUES 14 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE STATE
- 15 LIBRARY AID PROGRAM AND SHALL BE USED IN ADDITION TO, NOT TO SUPPLANT,
- 16 EXISTING FUNDING UNDER THE STATE LIBRARY AID PROGRAM AND USED FOR ONLY
- 17 THOSE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE OF THE
- 18 EDUCATION LAW.
- 19 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
