Introduced by Sen. CROCI -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Veterans, Homeland Security and Military Affairs -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to veterans' credits for civil service appointments and promotions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subparagraphs 1 and 2 of paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of  
2     section 85 of the civil service law, as added by chapter 790 of the laws  
3     of 1958, are amended to read as follows:  
4     (1) Disabled veterans shall be entitled to receive [ten] FIFTEEN  
5     points additional in a competitive examination for original appointment  
6     and [five] SEVEN AND ONE-HALF points additional credit in a competitive  
7     examination for promotion, and  
8     (2) Non-disabled veterans shall be entitled to receive [five] TEN  
9     points additional credit in a competitive examination for original  
10    appointment and [two and one-half] FIVE points additional credit in a  
11    competitive examination for promotion.  
12    S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding  
13    the date upon which the people shall approve and ratify an amendment  
14    to section 6 of article V of the constitution by a majority of the electors  
15    voting thereon relating to appointments and promotions in civil  
16    service.
