AN ACT to direct the department of transportation to conduct a study of level grade rail crossings

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The department of transportation shall, in consultation
2 with the metropolitan transportation authority, the department of motor
3 vehicles, the division of state police, the governor's traffic safety
4 committee, local governments, and any other department, division, board,
5 bureau, commission, agency or public authority of the state or any poli-
6 tical subdivision thereof deemed necessary by the commissioner of trans-
7 portation, conduct a statewide study of highway-railroad grade crossings
8 to determine whether adequate safety measures exist to prevent colli-
9 sions between trains and motor vehicles. Such study shall include, but
10 not be limited to, the design and safety of highway-railroad grade
11 crossings and the feasibility of implementing design changes to increase
12 safety and to reduce the likelihood of obstruction at such grade cross-
13 ings; adequacy of traffic and pedestrian warning signals; the availabil-
14 ity of federal funding for highway-railroad grade crossing improvement
15 projects; and the feasibility of equipping passenger and commuter trains
16 with technology to increase safety. Furthermore, the study shall include
17 data on highway-railroad grade crossing accidents and incidents that
18 have occurred within the state on an annual basis over the past five
19 years. The commissioner of transportation shall, on or before April 1,
20 2017, submit a report of such study, including detailed recommendations
