AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to requiring the developa program addressing the problem of wrong way drivers on New York interstate highways

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 67 to read as follows:
- S 67. WRONG WAY DRIVER PROGRAM. 1. WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THEDATE OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE 5 NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES, DEVELOP A PROGRAM ADDRESS THE PROBLEM OF WRONG WAY DRIVERS ON NEW YORK INTERSTATE HIGH-7 WAYS.
 - 2. SUCH PROGRAM SHALL:

- 9 A. INVESTIGATE POSSIBLE REASONS FOR THE PROBLEM OF WRONG WAY DRIVERS 10 ON NEW YORK INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS;
- 11 B. ASSESS WHAT OTHER STATES HAVE DONE TO ADDRESS THIS PROBLEM;
- C. SET FORTH POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS TO THE PROBLEM; AND 12
- TO REDUCE THE PROBLEM OF WRONG WAY DRIVERS ON 13 IMPLEMENT MEASURES
- 14 NEW YORK INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 15
