AN ACT to amend the real property actions and proceedings law, in relation to granting certain tenants the right to relocation costs from the proceeds of a foreclosure sale

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1354 of the real property actions and proceedings 2 law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 3 2-A. THE OFFICER CONDUCTING THE SALE SHALL PAY OUT OF THE PROCEEDS, 4 THE RELOCATION COSTS, NOT EXCEEDING ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS
- 5 PER LESSEE, OF ANY LESSEE OF AN INTEREST IN THE PROPERTY SOLD WHO IS
- 6 REQUIRED TO VACATE THE REAL PROPERTY PRIOR TO THE TERMINATION OF HIS OR
- 7 HER LEASE. 8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
