AN ACT authorizing the town of East Hampton, Suffolk county, to establish a tick control district

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The town of East Hampton, in the county of Suffolk, is hereby authorized to establish a tick control district pursuant to articles 12 and 12-A of the town law. Such tick control district shall be established, funded, operated and otherwise controlled by the provisions of articles 12 and 12-A of the town law and the provisions of this act. To the extent that the provisions of this act shall in any way be in conflict with articles 12 and 12-A of the town law, the provisions of this act shall be controlling.
