AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to loitering

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 240.35 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:
- 7. LOITERS OR REMAINS IN ANY TRANSPORTATION FACILITY, WITHIN TWENTY-FIVE FEET OF THE TOKEN BOOTH OR SIMILAR LOCATION, FOR MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE MINUTES, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED TO DO SO, UNLESS BECAUSE OF THE FACILITY'S SIZE OR DESIGN IT WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE TO MAINTAIN SUCH DISTANCE.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day next succeeding 9 the date on which it shall have become a law.
