AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing the John J. Marchi government studies scholarship program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 679-h 2 to read as follows:

3 S 679-н. SENATOR JOHN J. MARCHI GOVERNMENT STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP 4 PROGRAM. 1. PURPOSE. A. THE PRESIDENT SHALL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS TΟ 5 STUDENTS OF THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK WHO ARE ENROLLED IN GOVERN-6 MENT OR GOVERNMENT RELATED STUDIES. SUCH AWARDS SHALL BE MADE ON A 7 COMPETITIVE BASIS, AS PROMULGATED BY THE CORPORATION THROUGH RULES AND 8 REGULATIONS TO APPLICANTS WHO ARE ENROLLING IN AN APPROVED PROGRAM TO 9 OBTAIN A DEGREE IN GOVERNMENT OR GOVERNMENT RELATED STUDIES FROM THE 10 CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK.

11 B. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN AWARD PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION, APPLI-12 CANTS SHALL (1) BE A RESIDENT OF THE STATE; (2) ENROLL IN A DEGREE PROGRAM IN GOVERNMENT OR GOVERNMENT RELATED STUDIES; (3) ATTEND A 13 CITY 14 UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK SCHOOL; AND (4) COMPLY WITH SUBDIVISIONS THREE 15 AND FIVE OF SECTION SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE OF THIS PART.

16 2. AWARD CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS. SCHOLARSHIPS SHALL BE AWARDED ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS AS PROMULGATED BY THE CORPORATION THROUGH RULES AND 17 TO APPLICANTS WHOM THE CORPORATION HAS CERTIFIED ARE ELIGI-18 REGULATIONS BLE TO RECEIVE SUCH AWARDS; AND WHO AGREE TO PROVIDE 19 NOT LESS THAN 20 ACADEMIC CREDIT HOURS OR ITS EQUIVALENT FOR THE DURATION OF AT TWELVE 21 LEAST FOUR YEARS UPON COMPLETION OF THE DEGREE PROGRAM.

EQUAL TO THE TUITION CHARGED TO STATE RESIDENT STUDENTS ENROLLED IN A DEGREE PROGRAM WITH A MAJOR IN GOVERNMENT OR GOVERNMENT RELATED STUDIES; THE AVERAGE MANDATORY FEES CHARGED AT THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF 5 6 7 NEW YORK, OR THE ACTUAL TUITION AND FEES CHARGED TO THE RECIPIENT, 8 WHICHEVER IS LESS; AND THE AVERAGE NON-TUITION COST OF ATTENDANCE, AS DETERMINED BY THE CORPORATION AND AS APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE 9 10 BUDGET, FOR A STUDENT AT THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK OR ACTUAL NON-TUITION COST OF ATTENDANCE AT SUCH INSTITUTION, WHICHEVER IS LESS, 11 PROVIDED THAT THE SCHOLARSHIP SHALL NOT EXCEED AN AMOUNT THAT IS EQUAL 12 THE TOTAL COST OF ATTENDANCE DETERMINED FOR FEDERAL TITLE IV STUDENT 13 TO 14 FINANCIAL AID PURPOSES, LESS ALL OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS PROVIDED BY THE STATE, OTHER STATES, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR OTHER GOVERNMENTS, 15 16 AND THE AMOUNT OF EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS PAID UNDER ANY PROGRAM THAT WOULD DUPLICATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS PROGRAM, PROVIDED THAT ANY SCHOLARSHIPS 17 OR GRANTS PROVIDED TO A RECIPIENT BY THE INSTITUTION WHICH ARE 18 INTENDED 19 TO FUND ANY PORTION OF THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE ANNUAL STATE AWARD AND THE ACTUAL COSTS OF ATTENDANCE AT ANY SUCH INSTITUTION SHALL NOT BE 20 21 CONSIDERED TO DUPLICATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS PROGRAM.

B. THE TOTAL COST OF THE SENATOR JOHN J. MARCHI GOVERNMENT STUDIES
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM SHALL NOT EXCEED AN ANNUAL COST OF TWO MILLION
DOLLARS, AND NO ANNUAL AWARD SHALL EXCEED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS.
4. OTHER AWARDS. AWARD RECIPIENTS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR OTHER

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5. PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE. A. THE CORPORATION SHALL CONVERT TO A STUDENT LOAN THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE AWARD GIVEN PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, PLUS INTEREST, ACCORDING TO A SCHEDULE TO BE DETERMINED BY THE CORPORATION IF THE STUDENT FAILS TO RECEIVE A DEGREE IN GOVERNMENT OR GOVERNMENT RELATED STUDIES.

B. THE RATE OF INTEREST CHARGED FOR REPAYMENT OF THE STUDENT LOAN
 SHALL BE DETERMINED PURSUANT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE
 CORPORATION.
