AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to permitting pregnant women to enroll in the state health insurance exchange at any time

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 3114 2 to read as follows:
- s 1114. ENROLLMENT IN THE STATE HEALTH INSURANCE EXCHANGE; PREGNANCY.
 IN ADDITION TO ANY TRIGGERING EVENT THAT PROVIDES ELIGIBILITY FOR A
- 5 SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD AVAILABLE TO INDIVIDUALS FOR ENROLLMENT IN A 6 QUALIFIED HEALTH PLAN IN THE STATE HEALTH INSURANCE EXCHANGE ESTABLISHED
- 7 PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT (P.L.
- 8 111-148), THE STATE HEALTH INSURANCE EXCHANGE SHALL ALLOW FOR THE
- 9 ENROLLMENT OF A PREGNANT INDIVIDUAL AT ANY TIME AFTER THE COMMENCEMENT
- 10 OF THE PREGNANCY, TWO WEEKS AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL'S LAST MENSTRUAL PERI-
- 11 OD. UPON SUCH ENROLLMENT, ANY QUALIFIED HEALTH PLAN IN THE STATE HEALTH 12 INSURANCE EXCHANGE SHALL ENSURE THAT COVERAGE IS EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE
- 13 OF APPLICATION.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
