- AN ACT authorizing colleges and universities to offer additional programs and degrees

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or 1 special 2 law to the contrary, a college, as defined by section 2 of the education 3 law may offer or institute an additional program or degree if that 4 college (1) has maintained a physical presence and operated continuously in the state for the immediately preceding 10 years and (2) is accred-5 ited without sanction by Middle States Association of Colleges and 6 Schools or the New York state board of regents. Any such college that 7 does not satisfy all of the provisions of this section shall comply with 8 the procedures and criteria established by the board of regents. 9 S 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2016.
