AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to exclusion of certain services from employment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (f) of subdivision 2 of section 563 of the labor law, as added by chapter 413 of the laws of 1991, is amended and a new paragraph g is added to read as follows:

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- (f) a person who participates in a youth service program designed to foster a commitment to community service and occupational and educational development and who, while participating in that program, performs services in the community or attends school and receives a stipend designed to cover expenses incurred in performing services or attending school, and is eligible for an award or scholarship upon leaving the program[.]; AND

 m BE}$ PAID TO INDIVIDUALS IN A PARTICULAR WORK-RELIEF OR WORK-TRAINING PROGRAM.
- 21 S 2. Paragraphs (f) and (g) of subdivision 2 of section 565 of the 22 labor law, as added by chapter 675 of the laws of 1977, are amended and 23 a new paragraph (h) is added to read as follows:

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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(f) a person in a policymaking or advisory position, the duties of which ordinarily do not require more than eight hours per week to perform; [and]

- (g) an inmate of a custodial or penal institution[.]; AND

- 15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all individuals hired on or after such date.
