AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to exclusion of certain
services from employment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (f) of subdivision 2 of section 563 of the labor
2 law, as added by chapter 413 of the laws of 1991, is amended and a new
3 paragraph g is added to read as follows:
4 (f) a person who participates in a youth service program designed to
5 foster a commitment to community service and occupational and educa-
6 tional development and who, while participating in that program,
7 performs services in the community or attends school and receives a
8 stipend designed to cover expenses incurred in performing services or
9 attending school, and is eligible for an award or scholarship upon leav-
10 ing the program[.]; AND
11 (G) AN INDIVIDUAL AS PART OF AN UNEMPLOYMENT WORK-RELIEF OR
12 WORK-TRAINING PROGRAM ASSISTED OR FINANCED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY ANY
13 FEDERAL AGENCY OR ANY AGENCY OF THE STATE OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THER-
14 EOF PURSUANT TO A DECLARATION OF A DISASTER EMERGENCY BY THE PRESIDENT,
15 GOVERNOR OR CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE,
16 WHERE SUCH INDIVIDUAL FURNISHES TEMPORARY SERVICES TO THE STATE OR POLI-
17 TICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF IN CONNECTION WITH A RECOVERY FROM THE DISAS-
18 TER EMERGENCY, PROVIDED THAT NO FEDERAL LAW, RULE OR REGULATION SPECIF-
19 ICALLY MANDATES UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE COVERAGE BE PAID TO SUCH
20 INDIVIDUALS IN A PARTICULAR WORK-RELIEF OR WORK-TRAINING PROGRAM.
21 S 2. Paragraphs (f) and (g) of subdivision 2 of section 565 of the
22 labor law, as added by chapter 675 of the laws of 1977, are amended and
23 a new paragraph (h) is added to read as follows:

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1 (f) a person in a policymaking or advisory position, the duties of
2 which ordinarily do not require more than eight hours per week to
3 perform; [and]
4 (g) an inmate of a custodial or penal institution[.]; AND
5 (H) AN INDIVIDUAL AS PART OF AN UNEMPLOYMENT WORK-RELIEF OR
6 WORK-TRAINING PROGRAM ASSISTED OR FINANCED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY ANY
7 FEDERAL AGENCY OR ANY AGENCY OF THE STATE OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THERE-
8 OF PURSUANT TO A DECLARATION OF A DISASTER OR EMERGENCY BY THE PRESI-
9 DENT, GOVERNOR OR CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE
10 STATE, WHERE SUCH INDIVIDUAL FURNISHES TEMPORARY SERVICES TO THE STATE
11 OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF IN CONNECTION WITH A RECOVERY FROM THE
12 DISASTER EMERGENCY, PROVIDED THAT NO FEDERAL LAW, RULE OR REGULATION
13 SPECIFICALLY MANDATES UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE COVERAGE BE PAID TO SUCH
14 INDIVIDUALS IN A PARTICULAR WORK-RELIEF OR WORK-TRAINING PROGRAM.
15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all
16 individuals hired on or after such date.
