- AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to disputed agreements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 209 of the civil service law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 7 to read as follows:

7. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, FOR ANY 3 4 DISPUTE THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE DETERMI-5 NATION OF THE PUBLIC ARBITRATION PANEL ON A DISPUTED AGREEMENT SHALL NOT б CONTAIN AN INCREASE IN ALL COMPENSATION ITEMS SUBJECT TO NEGOTIATION 7 WHICH IS GREATER THEN TWO PERCENT MORE THAN ALL COMPENSATION ITEMS 8 SUBJECT TO NEGOTIATION RECEIVED BY THE EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION IN THE 9 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYER AND THE EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE AGREEMENT BEING ARBITRATED. 10

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. Effective immediately, 12 the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation neces-13 sary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are 14 authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such 15 effective date.
