AN ACT to amend chapter 38 of the laws of 1903, relating to the volunteer firemen's benevolent association of North Tonawanda, incorporating the same, providing for the payment of certain taxes and moneys thereto, and for the disposition of the same, in relation to funeral benefits for members of such association

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 38 of the laws of 1903, relating to 2 the volunteer firemen's benevolent association of North Tonawanda, 3 incorporating the same, providing for the payment of certain taxes and 4 moneys thereto, and for the disposition of the same, as amended by chap-5 ter 37 of the laws of 1906, is amended to read as follows:

6 S 1. Herman U. Berger, Charles L. Sommer, Lewis Wattengel, Charles 7 Kohler, August Conrad, William Stuermer, Charles Ray, August F. Gardei, 8 John F. Myers, and such other persons as shall hereafter become members 9 of the corporation hereby created and constituted, and their successors, are hereby created and constituted a body corporate under the name 10 and style of the volunteer firemen's benevolent association of North Tona-11 wanda, for the purpose of furnishing relief to disabled members of 12 said corporation and their families and providing for the defrayal of funeral 13 14 expenses of persons hereafter dying while members of said corporation by 15 payment, as its by-laws shall prescribe, to the widow, personal repre-16 sentative or next-of-kin of each such deceased member, as and for a funeral benefit, of such an amount[, not exceeding one hundred dollars,] 17 as said by-laws shall prescribe; and said corporation shall have perpet-18 19 ual succession.

20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
