AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to establishing a repowering advisory committee

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Sections 1020-jj and 1020-kk of the public authorities law,
2 as renumbered by chapter 388 of the laws of 2011, are renumbered
3 sections 1020-kk and 1020-ll and a new section 1020-jj is added to read
4 as follows:
5 S 1020-JJ. REPOWERING ADVISORY COMMITTEE. 1. THE AUTHORITY, IN COOPER-
6 ATION WITH ITS SERVICE PROVIDER, AS DEFINED UNDER SECTION THREE-B OF THE
7 PUBLIC SERVICE LAW, AND OWNER OF THE LEGACY LILCO POWER GENERATING
8 FACILITIES, IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO ESTABLISH WITHIN THE
9 AUTHORITY A REPOWERING ADVISORY COMMITTEE BY SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOU-
10 SAND SIXTEEN. THE REPOWERING ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMPRISED OF
11 ELEVEN MEMBERS, EACH OF THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES SHALL APPOINT ONE MEMBER:
12 TOWNS OF BROOKHAVEN, HUNTINGTON, AND HEMPSTEAD; VILLAGES OF PORT JEFFER-
13 SON, ASHAROKEN, AND NORTHPORT; SCHOOL DISTRICTS OF THREE VILLAGE, PORT
14 JEFFERSON UNION FREE, NORTHPORT - EAST NORTHPORT UNION FREE, OCEANSIDE
15 UNION FREE, AND NORTH SHORE CENTRAL. MEMBERS SHALL SERVE AT THE PLEAS-
16 URE OF THE ENTITY FROM WHICH THEY WERE APPOINTED. A CHAIRPERSON,
17 VICE-CHAIRPERSON AND SECRETARY OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE ELECTED BY A
18 MAJORITY OF MEMBERS OF SUCH COMMITTEE. A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE
19 COMMITTEE SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM, AND ACTION BY THE COMMITTEE SHALL
20 BE BY THE ASSENT OF A MAJORITY OF THOSE PRESENT, THERE BEING A QUORUM.
21 THE AUTHORITY SHALL PROVIDE SECRETARIAL, RECORD KEEPING, MEETING

1 SERVICES AND SUPPORT SERVICES TO THE COMMITTEE. THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
2 MAY REQUEST ASSISTANCE, AND THE SERVICES OF, ANY MUNICIPALITIES THAT ARE
3 WITHIN THE COUNTIES OF NASSAU AND SUFFOLK, AS IT MAY REQUIRE AND AS MAY
4 BE MADE AVAILABLE TO IT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CARRYING OUT ITS DUTIES UNDER
5 THIS ACT. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE ASSIST-
6 ANCE FROM ANY MUNICIPALITY IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK.

7 2. THE REPOWERING ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL BE CHARGED WITH THE FOLLOW-
8 ING DUTIES:

9 A. TO REPRESENT THE ECONOMIC, ENVIRONMENTAL, HEALTH AND SAFETY INTER-
10 ESTS OF THE RESIDENTS ADJACENT TO THE GENERATING FACILITIES CITED IN
11 SECTION FIVE OF PART W OF CHAPTER FIFTY-EIGHT OF THE LAWS OF TWO THOU-
12 SAND FIFTEEN;

13 B. TO PROVIDE INPUT AND REVIEW AND SUGGEST CHANGES TO ANY SOLICITA-
14 TION FOR RESPONSES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, REQUESTS FOR
15 PROPOSALS, REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS, OR REQUESTS FOR EXPRESSION OF
16 INTEREST, INVOLVING ANY LEGACY LILCO POWER GENERATING FACILITY PURSUANT
17 TO SECTION FIVE OF PART W OF CHAPTER FIFTY-EIGHT OF THE LAWS OF TWO
18 THOUSAND FIFTEEN; AND

19 C. TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS AND MAKE REPORTS TO THE AUTHORITY ON REPOW-
20 ERING, AND ADDITIONAL FACTORS SUCH AS ECONOMICS, INDUSTRY CONDITIONS,
21 LONG ISLAND BUSINESS AND PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT, AND ENVIRONMENTAL
22 EFFECTS.

23 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
