AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the definition of "public utility mass real property" for purposes of assessment ceilings for local public utility mass real property

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 499-hhhh of the real property tax  
2 law, as added by chapter 475 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as  
3 follows:  
4     3. "Public utility mass real property" means real property, including  
5 MAINS, PIPES, conduits, cables, lines, wires, poles, supports and enclo-  
6 sures for electrical conductors located on, above and below real proper-  
7 ty, which is used in the STORAGE, transmission and distribution of GAS,  
8 ELECTRICITY, STEAM, WATER, PETROLEUM AND ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE AS WELL AS  
9 REFRIGERATION, HEAT, telephone or telegraph service, and electromagnetic  
10 voice, video and data signals. Such term shall include all property  
11 described in paragraphs (d), (E) and (i) of subdivision twelve of  
12 section one hundred two of this chapter. Special franchise property as  
13 described in subdivision seventeen of section one hundred two of this  
14 chapter, and all property described in [paragraphs (a) and (b) and]  
15 subparagraphs (A), (B), (C) and (D) of paragraph (i) of subdivision  
16 twelve of section one hundred two of this chapter shall not be consid-  
17 ered public utility mass real property for purposes of this title.  
18     S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that the amend-  
19 ments to subdivision 3 of section 499-hhhh of the real property tax law  
20 made by section one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such  
21 section and shall be deemed repealed therewith.
