AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting cases and covers for wireless communications devices which are imitation weapons

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 871 of the general business law, as added by chapter 475 of the laws of 1988, is amended and a new subdivision 3 is added to read as follows:
- 2. "Imitation weapon" means any device or object, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY CASE OR COVER FOR A WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE, made of plastic, wood, metal or any other material which substantially dupli-7 cates or can reasonably be perceived to be an actual firearm, air rifle, 8 pellet qun, or "B-B" qun; unless such imitation weapon (a) is colored other than black, blue, silver or aluminum, (b) is marked with a non-re-9 movable orange stripe which is at least one inch in width and runs the 10 entire length of the barrel on each side and the front end of 11 and (c) has a barrel at least one inch in diameter that is 12 closed for a distance of not less than one-half inch from the front-end 13 its barrel with the same material of which the imitation weapon is 14 made. "Imitation weapon" does not include any nonfiring replica of an 15 16 antique firearm, the original of which was designed, manufactured and 17 produced prior to eighteen hundred ninety-eight.
- 18 3. "WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS DEVICE" MEANS A WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS 19 DEVICE AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION NINE OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED ONE OF 20 THE COUNTY LAW.
- 21 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
