THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 75-c of the banking law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 4 to read as follows:
 - 4. SOFTWARE THAT WOULD ALLOW THE USER TO ENTER HIS OR HER PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER IN A SPECIFIC MANNER THAT WOULD IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL THAT THE USER IS MAKING A WITHDRAWAL AGAINST HIS OR HER OWN VOLITION, WHILE AT THE SAME TIME ALLOWING THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE TO DISPERSE MONEY TO THE CUSTOMER AS IF THERE WERE NO PROBLEM.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 10 it shall have become a law.
