The commissioner of health [is authorized to] SHALL establish a DEVELOPMENTAL disability clinician advisory group of experienced clinicians and clinic administrators who have an understanding of the comprehensive needs of people with DEVELOPMENTAL disabilities. shall provide the commissioner and the department of health with information and data on the effect of policies, including proposed regulations or statutes, and of fiscal proposals, including rate setting and appropriations, on the delivery of supports and services for individuals with DEVELOPMENTAL disabilities including but not limited to the role of specialty services. SUCH GROUP SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING PERSONS OR THEIR DESIGNEES: THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE FOR PEOPLE WITH DEVELOP-MENTAL DISABILITIES, THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THREE APPOINTED BY TWO THEGOVERNOR, INDIVIDUALS EACH BY THE INDIVIDUALS TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND BY THE SPEAKER OF THEASSEMBLY. MEMBERS OF THE GROUP SHALL BE APPOINTED FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS AND SHALL MEET AT LEAST THREE TIMES IN EACH FULL CALENDAR YEAR DURING FIRST TWO YEARS AND ADDITIONALLY UPON THE REQUEST OF THE COMMISSIONER OF
