AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the safe disposal of unused controlled substances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3343-b of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

4. THE COMMISSIONER IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO REQUIRE CHAIN PHARMACIES TO OPERATE DRUG DISPOSAL SITES FOR UNUSED CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES IN EACH COUNTY OF THE STATE, PROVIDED SUCH CHAIN PHARMACY HAS A PHARMACY LOCATED IN A COUNTY. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DETERMINE AND DESIGNATE DRUG DISPOSAL SITES BASED ON THE GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION AND NUMBER OF LOCATIONS SUCH CHAIN PHARMACY OWNS IN EACH COUNTY. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, "CHAIN PHARMACY" MEANS A PHARMACY WITH MORE THAN TWENTY LOCATIONS IN THE STATE.
