AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to keeping drinks containing alcoholic beverages in kegs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 106 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as added by chapter 512 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) of this subdivision, a retail licensee for on-premises consumption may prepare and keep drinks containing alcoholic beverages in dispensing machines, [having capacities of not less than a gallon, which continually mix such drinks] KEGS, SELTZER BOTTLES, OR OTHER CONTAINERS. THE STATE LIQUOR AUTHORITY SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE SIZE AND TYPE OF CONTAINERS FOR USE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
