AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to prohibiting any state agency or public authority from contracting for goods and services with a contractor or a subsidiary thereof, when the contractor or a subsidiary thereof also provides consulting services or products relating to the activity for which the state agency or public authority seeks to contract

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 2 139-1 to read as follows:

S 139-L. DISQUALIFICATION TO CONTRACT WITH CERTAIN STATE AGENCIES. NO STATE DEPARTMENT, BOARD, BUREAU, COMMISSION, DIVISION, OFFICE, COUNCIL OR COMMITTEE, OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY WITH AT LEAST ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR OR WHO SERVES AS A MEMBER BY VIRTUE OF HOLDING A CIVIL OFFICE OF THE STATE, SHALL CONTRACT WITH ANY ENTITY OR SUBSIDIARY THEREOF FOR THE PROVISION OF ANY GOOD OR SERVICE RELATED TO ANY ACTIVITIES THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE REGULATION OF SUCH STATE AGENCY OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY, WHEN SUCH ENTITY OR ANY SUBSIDIARY THEREOF PROVIDES, IN ANY
