- AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to authorizing the state liquor authority to impose a one year moratorium on the issuance of new licenses to sell liquor on premises in certain instances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage 2 control law, as amended by chapter 118 of the laws of 2012, is amended 3 to read as follows:

To limit in its discretion the number of licenses of each class to 5 issued within the state or any political subdivision thereof, and in be б connection therewith to prohibit the acceptance of applications for such 7 class or classes of licenses which have been so limited. 1 THIS CHAPTER AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR SUCH LICENSES. 2 NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL PREVENT THE TRANSFER OF ANY 3 LICENSE AT THE SAME PREMISES UNDER THIS CHAPTER. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS 4 SUBDIVISION, "NEIGHBORHOOD" MEANS A GEOGRAPHIC AREA WITHIN A CITY HAVING 5 A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY THE RESIDENTS 6 THEREOF AS INCLUDING A UNIQUE COMMUNITY OF INTERESTS.

This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-38 ments to subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage control 39 law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration 40 and reversion of such subdivision pursuant to section 4 of chapter 118 41 of the laws of 2012, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of 42 section two of this act shall take effect.
