AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring police agencies to take reports of missing adults whenever the adult is reported to be missing

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Lamont 2 Dottin's law".
  - S 2. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 837-f-2 to read as follows:
- 837-F-2. MISSING ADULTS. IN THE EVENT THAT A POLICE AGENCY RECEIVES 6 A REPORT THAT AN ADULT PERSON IS MISSING FROM HIS OR HER NORMAL AND 7 PLACE OF RESIDENCE AND WHOSE WHEREABOUTS CANNOT BE DETERMINED 8 BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHOSE RELATIONSHIP WITH SUCH ADULT PERSON WOULD 9 INDIVIDUAL IN A POSITION TO HAVE KNOWLEDGE OF HIS OR HER WHERE-ABOUTS, AND THAT SUCH MISSING ADULT PERSON HAS A PROVEN DISABILITY, OR 10 PHYSICAL DANGER, OR IS MISSING AFTER A CATASTROPHE, OR MAY 11 HAVE DISAPPEARED INVOLUNTARILY, OR IS MISSING UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES WHERE 12 13 THERE IS A REASONABLE CONCERN FOR HIS OR HER SAFETY; AND SUCH MISSING ADULT PERSON DOES NOT QUALIFY AS EITHER A MISSING CHILD 14 PURSUANT SECTION EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN-E OF THIS ARTICLE OR A VULNERABLE 15 16 ADULT PURSUANT TO SECTION EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN-F-1 OF THIS 17 POLICE AGENCY SHALL COLLECT INFORMATION NECESSARY TO FILE AN THE ELECTRONIC REPORT REGARDING THE MISSING ADULT PERSON WITH THE NATIONAL
- 18 INFORMATION CENTER REGISTER AND SUBMIT SUCH ELECTRONIC REPORT TO 19

THE NATIONAL CRIME INFORMATION CENTER REGISTER.

S 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it 21 22 have become a law.
