AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to prohibiting the unlawful use of a drone

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.80 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 S 240.80 UNLAWFUL USE OF A DRONE.
- 4 1. A PERSON IS GUILTY OF UNLAWFUL USE OF A DRONE WHEN HE OR SHE OPER-5 ATES SUCH DRONE IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH HOBBY USE.
 - 2. AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

- 7 (A) "DRONE" MEANS AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT WHICH IS OPERATED REMOTELY WITH-8 OUT THE POSSIBILITY OF DIRECT HUMAN INTERVENTION FROM WITHIN OR ON THE 9 AIRCRAFT.
- 10 (B) "HOBBY USE" MEANS THE USE OF A DRONE:
 - (I) DURING DAYTIME HOURS; AND
- 12 (II) WITHIN PRIVATELY OWNED AIR SPACE WHOSE OWNER HAS AUTHORIZED SUCH 13 USE; OR WITHIN PUBLICLY OWNED AIR SPACE AS AUTHORIZED BY LOCAL ORDI-
- 14 NANCE, STATE AND/OR FEDERAL LAW.
- 15 UNLAWFUL USE OF A DRONE IS A CLASS A MISDEMEANOR.
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
