AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to protecting registered security guards in a hospital or health care facility from assault

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 3 and 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law,  
2 subdivision 3 as amended by chapter 472 of the laws of 2015 and subdivi-  
3 sion 11 as separately amended by chapters 472 and 487 of the laws of  
4 2015, are amended to read as follows:  
5 3. With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, prosecu-  
6 tor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal  
7 procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, public health  
8 sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sanitation enforce-  
9 ment agent, New York city sanitation worker, a firefighter, including a  
10 firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical technician admin-  
11 istering first aid in the course of performance of duty as such fire-  
12 fighter, an emergency medical service paramedic or emergency medical  
13 service technician, or medical or related personnel in a hospital emer-  
14 gency department, A REGISTERED SECURITY GUARD IN A HOSPITAL OR HEALTH  
15 CARE FACILITY, a city marshal, a school crossing guard appointed pursu-  
16 ant to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, a traf-  
17 fic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, from performing a  
18 lawful duty, by means including releasing or failing to control an  
19 animal under circumstances evincing the actor's intent that the animal  
20 obstruct the lawful activity of such peace officer, police officer,  
21 prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the  
22 criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse,  
23 public health sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sani-  
24 tation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, firefighter,  
25 paramedic, technician, city marshal, school crossing guard appointed  
26 pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law,  
27 traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, he or she  
28 causes physical injury to such peace officer, police officer, prosecutor

13 subdivisions, a city marshal, a school crossing guard appointed pursuant  
14 to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, a traffic  
15 enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in  
16 subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law,  
17 sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, public  
18 health sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, registered  
19 nurse, licensed practical nurse, emergency medical service paramedic,  
20 [or] emergency medical service technician, OR A REGISTERED SECURITY  
21 GUARD IN A HOSPITAL OR HEALTH CARE FACILITY, he or she causes physical  
22 injury to such train operator, ticket inspector, conductor, signalper-  
23 son, bus operator or station agent, city marshal, school crossing guard  
24 appointed pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipi-  
25 pal law, traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prose-  
26 cutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the crimi-  
27 nal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, public  
28 health sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sanitation  
29 enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, emergency medical  
30 service paramedic, [or] emergency medical service technician, OR A  
31 REGISTERED SECURITY GUARD IN A HOSPITAL OR HEALTH CARE FACILITY, while  
32 such employee is performing an assigned duty on, or directly related to,  
33 the operation of a train or bus, or such city marshal, school crossing  
34 guard, traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecu-  
35 tor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal  
36 procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, public health  
37 sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sanitation enforce-  
38 ment agent, New York city sanitation worker, emergency medical service  
39 paramedic, [or] emergency medical service technician, OR A REGISTERED  
40 SECURITY GUARD IN A HOSPITAL OR HEALTH CARE FACILITY is performing an  
41 assigned duty.

42 S 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same  
43 manner as chapter 472 of the laws of 2015, takes effect.
