- AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to establishing business franchise and personal income tax gifts for state veterans' homes; and to amend the state finance law, in relation to establishing the veterans' home assistance fund

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 209-J to 2 read as follows:

S 209-J. GIFT FOR NEW YORK STATE VETERANS' HOMES. 3 EFFECTIVE FOR ANY 4 TAX YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN, 5 ANY TAXPAYER IN ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE VETER-SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE IN ANY WHOLE 6 ANS' HOME ASSISTANCE FUND. 7 DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY SUCH 8 TAXPAYER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE CORPORATE INCOME TAX RETURN TO ENABLE A TAXPAYER TO MAKE SUCH CONTRIBUTION. 9 NOTWITH-STANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, ALL REVENUES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO 10 THIS SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE VETERANS' HOME ASSISTANCE FUND AND 11 USED ONLY FOR THOSE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN SECTION EIGHTY-ONE 12 OF THE 13 STATE FINANCE LAW.

14 S 2. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 627-c to read as 15 follows:

16 S 627-C. GIFT FOR NEW YORK STATE VETERANS' HOMES. EFFECTIVE FOR ANY 17 YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN, TAX 18 AN INDIVIDUAL IN ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE VETER-SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE IN ANY WHOLE 19 ANS ' HOME ASSISTANCE FUND. DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY 20 SUCH INDIVIDUAL. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE PERSONAL INCOME 21 TAX RETURN TO ENABLE A TAXPAYER TO MAKE SUCH CONTRIBUTION. NOTWITHSTAND-22 23 ING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, ALL REVENUES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS 24 SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE VETERANS' HOME ASSISTANCE FUND AND USED

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ONLY FOR THOSE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN SECTION EIGHTY-ONE OF THE STATE 1 2 FINANCE LAW. 3 state finance law is amended by adding a new section 81 to S 3. The 4 read as follows: 5 S 81. VETERANS' HOME ASSISTANCE FUND. 1. THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED 6 IN THE JOINT CUSTODY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF TAXATION AND FINANCE AND THE 7 COMPTROLLER, A SPECIAL FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE "VETERANS' HOME ASSIST-8 ANCE FUND". 9 2. SUCH FUND SHALL CONSIST OF ALL REVENUES RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT 10 TAXATION AND FINANCE, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS TWO OF HUNDRED NINE-J AND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN-C OF THE TAX LAW, AND ALL 11 12 OTHER MONEYS APPROPRIATED, CREDITED OR TRANSFERRED THERETO FROM ANY OTHER FUND OR SOURCE PURSUANT TO LAW. FOR EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR, 13 THERE SHALL BE APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND BY THE STATE, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER 14 MONEYS REQUIRED TO BE DEPOSITED INTO SUCH FUND, AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE 15 16 AGGREGATE OF THE AMOUNTS OF MONEYS COLLECTED AND DEPOSITED INTO THE 17 HOME ASSISTANCE FUND PURSUANT TO SECTIONS TWO HUNDRED NINE-J VETERANS ' 18 AND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN-C OF THE TAX LAW AND ALL OTHER MONEYS 19 RECEIVED AND DEPOSITED INTO SUCH FUND FROM GRANTS, GIFTS AND BEQUESTS 20 DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PROCEEDING CALENDAR YEAR. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION 21 SHALL PREVENT THE STATE FROM SOLICITING AND RECEIVING GRANTS, GIFTS OR BEQUESTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE FUND AS DEFINED IN THIS SECTION AND 22 DEPOSITING THEM INTO THE FUND ACCORDING TO LAW. 23 24 3. ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST OF FEBRUARY EACH YEAR, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL 25 CERTIFY TO THE GOVERNOR, THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF SENATE, THE THE26 SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE CHAIR OF THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND 27 THE CHAIR OF THE ASSEMBLY WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE, THE AMOUNT OF MONIES 28 DEPOSITED INTO THE VETERANS' HOME ASSISTANCE FUND DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR AS THE RESULT OF REVENUES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO 29 30 SECTIONS TWO HUNDRED NINE-J AND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN-C OF THE TAX LAW, AND FROM ALL GRANTS, GIFTS AND BEQUESTS TO SUCH FUND. 31 32 4. MONEYS OF THE FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED ONLY FOR THE CARE AND MAINTE-33 NANCE OF VETERANS' HOMES OPERATED BY AGENCIES OF THE STATE, AND SHALL BE DISBURSED EQUALLY EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR TO EACH OF THE FOLLOWING FIVE 34 35 VETERANS' HOMES: THE STATE HOME FOR VETERANS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS AT OXFORD, THE STATE HOME FOR VETERANS IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK, THE STATE 36 37 HOME FOR VETERANS AT BATAVIA, THE STATE HOME FOR VETERANS AT MONTROSE 38 AND THE LONG ISLAND STATE VETERANS HOME AT STONY BROOK UNIVERSITY. 39 5. MONEYS SHALL BE PAYABLE FROM THE FUND ON THE AUDIT AND WARRANT OF 40 THE COMPTROLLER ON VOUCHERS APPROVED AND CERTIFIED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH, FOR VETERANS' HOMES OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, AND 41 BY THE COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION, FOR THE VETERANS' HOME OPERATED BY THE 42 43 STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK. 44 6. MONEYS IN THE VETERANS' HOME ASSISTANCE FUND SHALL BE KEPT SEPARATE 45 AND SHALL NOT BE COMMINGLED WITH ANY OTHER MONEYS IN THE CUSTODY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF TAXATION AND FINANCE AND/OR THE COMPTROLLER. 46 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately. 47
