- AN ACT to amend the economic development law, the public authorities law and the New York state urban development corporation act, in relation to providing a preference to small businesses and entrepreneurs in the award of state economic development assistance

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The economic development law is amended by adding a new 2 section 101-a to read as follows:

3 S 101-A. PREFERENCES TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. IN EACH 4 PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO AN 5 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, AND CONSISTENT WITH ANY STATUTE GOVERNING SUCH 6 PREFERENCE SHALL BE GIVEN TO THE AWARD OF SUCH FUNDS TO SMALL PROGRAM, 7 BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. SUCH PREFERENCE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE 8 LIMITED TO, ACTIVE MARKETING OF THE PROGRAM SPECIFICALLY TO SMALL BUSI-NESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS, PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUAL SMALL BUSI-9 NESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS IN ACCESSING AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM, 10 AND ESTABLISHING AND WORKING TO MEET THE GOAL OF AWARDING TWENTY PERCENT 11 OF AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM TO SMALL BUSINESSES 12 AND ENTREPRE-13 NEURS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "ENTREPRENEUR" SHALL MEAN A PERSON WHO ORGANIZES, OPERATES, AND ASSUMES THE 14 RISK OF A START-UP 15 BUSINESS VENTURE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL REPORT 16 REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION THIRTY-SEVEN-A OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED 17 THIS ARTICLE A DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES, A LISTING OF PROPOSALS OF 18 RECEIVING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND IDENTIFY 19 WHETHER THE TWENTY PERCENT GOAL WAS MET FOR EACH PROGRAM.

20 S 2. Section 1823 of the public authorities law is amended by adding a 21 new subdivision 8 to read as follows:

8. IN EACH PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE AUTHORITY, AND
CONSISTENT WITH ANY STATUTE GOVERNING SUCH PROGRAM, PREFERENCE SHALL BE
GIVEN TO THE AWARD OF SUCH FUNDS TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS.
SUCH PREFERENCE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, ACTIVE MARKETING

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THE PROGRAM SPECIFICALLY TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS, 1 OF PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUAL SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS IN 2 3 ACCESSING AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM, AND ESTABLISHING AND WORK-4 ING TO MEET THE GOAL OF AWARDING TWENTY PERCENT OF AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER 5 THE PROGRAM TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS 6 THE TERM "SMALL BUSINESS" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SUBDIVISION, 7 PROVIDED IN SECTION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 8 TERM "ENTREPRENEUR" SHALL MEAN A PERSON OR PERSONS WHO LAW AND THE ORGANIZES, OPERATES, AND ASSUMES THE RISK OF A START-UP BUSINESS 9 10 VENTURE. THE AUTHORITY SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL PROGRAM REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION EIGHTEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE-A OF 11 THIS A DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES, A LISTING OF PROPOSALS PROVIDED WITH 12 TITLE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND IDENTIFY WHETHER 13 THE 14 TWENTY PERCENT GOAL WAS MET FOR EACH PROGRAM.

15 S 3. Section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968 constituting the New 16 York state urban development corporation act is amended by adding a new 17 section 4-a to read as follows:

S 4-A. PREFERENCES TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. 18 IN EACH 19 PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE CORPORATION PURSUANT TO AN 20 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, AND CONSISTENT WITH ANY STATUTE GOVERNING SUCH PROGRAM, PREFERENCE SHALL BE GIVEN TO THE AWARD OF SUCH FUNDS TO SMALL 21 22 BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. SUCH PREFERENCE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE 23 LIMITED TO, ACTIVE MARKETING OF THE PROGRAM SPECIFICALLY TO SMALL BUSI-NESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS, PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUAL SMALL BUSI-24 25 NESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS IN ACCESSING AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM, AND ESTABLISHING AND WORKING TO MEET THE GOAL OF AWARDING TWENTY PERCENT 26 AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRE-27 OF FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "SMALL BUSINESS" 28 NEURS. SHALL THE SAME MEANING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 131 OF THE ECONOMIC DEVEL-29 HAVE OPMENT LAW AND THE TERM "ENTREPRENEUR" SHALL MEAN A PERSON OR PERSONS 30 WHO ORGANIZES, OPERATES, AND ASSUMES THE RISK OF A START-UP BUSINESS 31 32 VENTURE. THE CORPORATION SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL PROGRAM REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION THIRTY OF THIS ACT A DESCRIPTION OF ACTIV-33 ITIES, A LISTING OF PROPOSALS PROVIDED WITH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PURSU-34 35 ANT TO THIS SECTION AND IDENTIFY WHETHER THE TWENTY PERCENT GOAL WAS MET 36 FOR EACH PROGRAM.

37 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
