AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to directing the commissioner of health to make recommendations relating to increasing certain ambulatory patient group reimbursement rates

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2-a of section 2807 of the public health law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (j) to read as follows:
- 3 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH HOSPITAL INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVES, PROVIDE WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN, INCREASING AMBULATORY PATIENT 6 GROUPS REIMBURSEMENT RATES ESTABLISHED 7 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION FOR GENERAL HOSPITAL OUTPATIENT 8 GENERAL HOSPITAL EMERGENCY SERVICES, DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT CENTER SERVICES AND AMBULATORY SURGICAL SERVICES, PROVIDED BY RURAL HOSPITALS 9 DESIGNATED AS CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE XVIII 10 OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT. SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL TAKE INTO 11 CONSIDERATION THE INCREASED COSTS OF PROVIDING SUCH SERVICES 12 WELL AS THE NEED TO MAINTAIN ACCESS TO SUCH SERVICES IN RURAL 13 AREAS AS AREAS. IN ADDITION, THE RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL CONTAIN PROPOSED LEGIS-14 INCORPORATION INTO THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE TWO THOUSAND 15 LATION, FOR 16 SEVENTEEN--TWO THOUSAND EIGHTEEN FISCAL YEAR, TO EFFECTUATE
- 18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

INCREASES EFFECTIVE APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN.
