AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to operators of a vehicle overtaking a bicycle from behind

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1122-a of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 413 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:
 - S 1122-a. Overtaking a bicycle. 1. The operator of a vehicle overtaking, from behind, a bicycle proceeding on the same side of a roadway shall pass to the left of such bicycle at a [safe] distance OF NOT LESS THAN THREE FEET until safely clear thereof.
- 7 2. THE COLLISION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE 8 ON THE SAME SIDE OF A ROADWAY SHALL BE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF THE OPER-9 ATOR'S FAILURE TO PASS SUCH BICYCLIST AT A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN THREE 10 FEET UNTIL SAFELY CLEAR THEREOF.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
