AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to providing premium reductions for non-commercial motor vehicles equipped with dashboard cameras

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2336 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (i) to read as follows:

- (I) ANY SCHEDULE OR RATING PLAN FOR NON-COMMERCIAL PRIVATE PASSENGER INSURANCE SHALL PROVIDE FOR A FIVE PERCENT REDUCTION IN PREMIUM CHARGES FOR BODILY INJURY LIABILITY, PROPERTY DAMAGE LIABILITY, PERSONAL INJURY PROTECTION, MEDICAL PAYMENTS AND COLLISION COVERAGE WITH RESPECT TO AUTOMOBILES EQUIPPED WITH A DASHBOARD CAMERA. THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF MOTOR VEHICLES, PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR SUCH DASHBOARD CAMERAS.
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to all
  policies issued, renewed, modified, altered or amended on or after such
  date. Provided, however, that, effective immediately, any and all rules
  and regulations and any other measures necessary to implement the
  provisions of this act on its effective date are authorized and directed
  to be completed on or before such date.
