AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to the tolling of the statute of limitations relating to personal injury caused by contact with or exposure to ground water contaminated by substances, compounds or toxins

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The civil practice law and rules is amended by adding a new 2 section 214-f to read as follows:

S 214-F. ACTION TO RECOVER DAMAGES FOR PERSONAL INJURY CAUSED BY CONTACT WITH OR EXPOSURE TO GROUND WATER CONTAMINATED BY SUBSTANCES, COMPOUNDS OR TOXINS. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, AN ACTION TO RECOVER DAMAGES FOR PERSONAL INJURY CAUSED BY CONTACT WITH OR EXPOSURE TO GROUND WATER CONTAMINATED BY IDENTIFIABLE SUBSTANCE OR SUBSTANCES, COMPOUND OR COMPOUNDS, OR TOXIN OR TOXINS MAY BE COMMENCED WITHIN THIRTY MONTHS OR TWO YEARS AND SIX MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF THE DISCOVERY OF SUCH INJURY, OR WITHIN TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE

11 WHEN THROUGH THE EXERCISE OR REASONABLE DILIGENCE THE CAUSE OF 12 INJURY SHOULD HAVE BEEN DISCOVERED, WHICHEVER IS LATER.

13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
