AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the state office of religious and independent schools establishment act

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new article 12-B to read as follows:

ARTICLE 12-B

STATE OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS

SECTION 571. SHORT TITLE.

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572. STATE OFFICE FOR RELIGIOUS AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS.

573. RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- SHORT TITLE. THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE "STATE OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS ESTABLISHMENT 10 ACT".
  - 572. STATE OFFICE FOR RELIGIOUS AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS. 1. THE STATE OFFICE FOR RELIGIOUS AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE AND COORDINATE SERVICES AND ADMINISTER STATE AND FEDERAL PROGRAMS AND APPROPRIATIONS, AS MAY BE IDENTIFIED BY THE COMMISSIONER, INTENDED FOR THE BENEFIT OF STUDENTS AND PERSONNEL RELIGIOUS AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS AND TO DISSEMINATE INFORMATION AND CARRY OUT ANY RESPONSIBILITIES THE DEPARTMENT MAY HAVE TOWARD RELIGIOUS AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS.
  - DEPARTMENT, ON BEHALF OF THE OFFICE, SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT AND RECEIVE ANY GRANTS, AWARDS, APPROPRIATIONS OR OTHER FUNDS MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE TO CARRY OUT THE FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE. ALL SUCH FUNDS RECEIVED BY OR OTHERWISE MADE AVAILABLE TO THEIN A DISTINCT ACCOUNT OR ACCOUNTS ADMINISTERED BY THE SHALL BE  $\mathtt{HELD}$ DEPARTMENT TO CARRY OUT THE FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE.
- 25 3. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL UTILIZE STATE AND/OR FEDERAL FUNDS APPROPRI-26 ATED OR AUTHORIZED FOR PERSONNEL SERVICES TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF 27 THIS ACT.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that any rules or regulations necessary for the implementation of this act shall be promulgated and take effect 180 days after such effective date.
