THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision a of section 40 of the 2 retirement and social security law is amended to read as follows:
- Each person who becomes a member of the retirement system shall file a duly executed [and acknowledged] application with the comptroller. Such pplication shall contain:
- 6 S 2. The opening paragraph of subdivision a of section 340 of the 7 retirement and social security law, as added by chapter 1000 of the laws 8 of 1966, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 After the effective date of this article, each person who becomes a 10 member of the [policemen's and firemen's] NEW YORK STATE AND LOCAL 11 POLICE AND FIRE retirement system shall file a duly executed [and 12 acknowledged] application with the comptroller. Such application shall 13 contain:
- 14 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
