AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to waiving the residency requirement for the code/zoning enforcement officer in the village of Aurora, Cayuga county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 26 to read as follows:
  - 26. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER GENER-AL LAW, LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR SPECIAL ACT, THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUS-INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF AURORA, CAYUGA COUNTY, MAY, BY TEES OF THERESOLUTION, PROVIDE THAT THE CODE/ZONING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF VILLAGE OF AURORA, CAYUGA COUNTY, NEED NOT BE A RESIDENT OF SUCH VILLAGE, BUT MUST BE A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA, STATE OF NEW YORK, OR OF A COUNTY WHICH ADJOINS THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA.
- 10 Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new 11 subdivision 65 to read as follows:
  - 65. IN THE VILLAGE OF AURORA, IN THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA, THE PROVISIONS SECTION REQUIRING A PERSON TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL THIS SUBDIVISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE FOR WHICH HE SHE SHALL BE CHOSEN OR WITHIN WHICH HIS OR HER OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS ARE REQUIRED TO BE EXERCISED SHALL NOT PREVENT A PERSON FROM HOLDING THE CODE/ZONING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON RESIDES IN THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA OR AN ADJOINING COUNTY WITHIN THE YORK. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE PERSON PERFORMING THE FUNCTIONS OF
- 19 20 CODE/ZONING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN ANY OTHER VILLAGE SHALL BE A RESIDENT
- 21 OF SUCH VILLAGE, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.
- 22 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
