AN ACT relating to providing certain health insurance benefits to Yvonne D. Mosca upon her retirement

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of state or local law to the contrary, Yvonne D. Mosca, a current tier 2 member of the New York state and local employees' retirement system, who was an employee of the city of Mount Vernon from 1975 until 1985, who was rehired by such city in 1995 and who was employed by the New York state legislature from 1985 until 1995, shall be entitled to receive full family coverage under the New York state health insurance program upon her retirement. One hundred percent of the costs of such coverage shall be borne by the city of Mount Vernon.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL NOTE. -- Pursuant to Legislative Law, Section 50:
