AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the issuance of a new driver's license to identify theft victims

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 505 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:

- IDENTITY THEFT. A LICENSEE OR APPLICANT WHO HAS BEEN THE VICTIM OF IDENTITY THEFT ARISING FROM THEFT OF THE LICENSEE'S OR APPLICANT'S LICENSE MAY APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR A NEW LICENSE. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REQUIRE SUCH PERSON TO SUBMIT PROOF ACCEPTABLE TO HIM OR HER RESPECT TO THE FACTS, AND UPON APPROVAL OF SUCH PROOF, AND THE SURRENDER THE PRIOR LICENSE IF SUCH LICENSE IS IN THE POSSESSION OF THE APPLI-CANT, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE A NEW LICENSE AT NO FEE. THE COMMIS-SIONER SHALL PROMULGATE ALL NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION, INCLUDING THOSE PERTAINING TO WHAT PROOF OF THE FACTS IS SUFFICIENT TO ESTABLISH IDENTI-TY THEFT.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
