AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to part-time tuition assistance program awards

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 667-c of the education law, as
2 added by section 1 of part N of chapter 58 of the laws of 2006, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 2. For purposes of this section, a part-time student is one who:
5 a. enrolled as a first-time freshman during the two thousand six--two
6 thousand seven academic year or thereafter at a college or university
7 within the state university, including a statutory or contract college,
8 a community college established pursuant to article one hundred twenty-
9 six of this chapter, the city university of New York, or a non-profit
10 college or university incorporated by the regents or by the legislature;
11 b. [has earned at least twelve credits in each of two consecutive
12 semesters at one of the institutions named in paragraph a of this subdi-
13 vision by the time of the awards;
14 c.] is enrolled for at least six but less than twelve semester hours,
15 or the equivalent, per semester in an approved undergraduate degree
16 program; and
17 [d] C. has a cumulative grade-point average of at least 2.00.
18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
