- AN ACT to amend the not-for-profit corporation law, in relation to powers and dissolution of land banks

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraphs 20 and 21 of paragraph (a) of section 1607 of 2 the not-for-profit corporation law, as added by chapter 257 of the laws 3 of 2011, are amended to read as follows:

4 (20) to enter in agreements with a foreclosing governmental unit for 5 the distribution of revenues to the foreclosing governmental unit and 6 school district; [and]

7 (21) TO ORGANIZE A SUBSIDIARY FOR A PROJECT OR PROJECTS WHICH THE LAND 8 BANK HAS THE POWER TO PURSUE HEREUNDER WHEN THE PRIMARY REASON FOR WHICH 9 SUBSIDIARY SHALL BE ORGANIZED SHALL BE TO LIMIT THE POTENTIAL THE LIABILITY IMPACT OF THE SUBSIDIARY'S PROJECT OR PROJECTS ON 10 THELAND BANK OR BECAUSE STATE OR FEDERAL LAW REQUIRES THAT THE PURPOSE OF A 11 12 SUBSIDIARY BE UNDERTAKEN THROUGH A SPECIFIC CORPORATE OR BUSINESS STRUC-TURE. ALL REAL PROPERTY OF A SUBSIDIARY ORGANIZED HEREUNDER 13 SHALL BE 14 MAINTAINED ON THE INVENTORY LISTS REQUIRED IN THIS ARTICLE OF THE LAND BANK OF WHICH IT IS A SUBSIDIARY AND 15 THE SUBSIDIARY SHALL MAKE ALL REPORTS AND OTHER DISCLOSURES AS ARE REQUIRED OF LAND BANKS UNDER THIS 16 17 ARTICLE AND AS LOCAL PUBLIC AUTHORITIES, UNLESS THE SUBSIDIARY'S OPER-FINANCES ARE CONSOLIDATED WITH THOSE OF THE LAND BANK OF 18 ATIONS AND 19 WHICH IT IS A SUBSIDIARY. SUBSIDIARIES ORGANIZED HEREUNDER SHALL ΒE 20 ESTABLISHED THE FORM OF A NEW YORK CHARITABLE NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPO-IN RATION OR A NEW YORK SINGLE MEMBER LIMITED LIABILITY 21 COMPANY. SUBSID-22 HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS, NOTES OR OTHER IARIES SHALL NOT DEBTS, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH SUBSIDIARIES MAY 23 ISSUE NOTES OR 24 OTHER DEBT TO THE LAND BANK OF WHICH IT IS A SUBSIDIARY. THE ORGANIZA-25 TIONAL DOCUMENTS FILED TO CREATE A SUBSIDIARY HEREUNDER SHALL STATE THAT THE LAND BANK IS ORGANIZING THE SUBSIDIARY FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH 26

S². Paragraph (a) of section 1609 of the not-for-profit corporation 9 10 law, as added by chapter 257 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows: 11

12 (a) The land bank shall hold in its own name, OR IN THE NAME OF A LAWFULLY ORGANIZED SUBSIDIARY, all real property acquired by the land 13 14 bank irrespective of the identity of the transferor of such property.

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 15
