AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing the "help individuals reach employment program" (HIRE)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 355-d 2 to read as follows:

3 S 355-D. HELP INDIVIDUALS REACH EMPLOYMENT. 1. THE "HELP INDIVIDUALS 4 REACH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM" (HIRE) IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE ADDI-5 TIONAL SKILLS FOR COLLEGE GRADUATES TO INCREASE THEIR EMPLOYMENT MARKET-6 ABILITY AND ATTAIN SUCCESSFUL JOB PLACEMENT.

7 2. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HIRE PROGRAM, AN APPLICANT 8 SHALL HAVE: (A) RECEIVED AN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE FROM THE STATE UNIVER-9 SITY OF NEW YORK AND HAVE ACHIEVED A GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF 3.0 OR HIGH-10 ER; (B) COMPLETED THEIR DEGREE IN NO MORE THAN FIVE YEARS, OR SIX YEARS 11 IF THE DEGREE TYPICALLY REOUIRES FIVE YEARS; (C) COMPLETED AN APPROVED EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING ACTIVITY, AS DEFINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; (D) 12 GRADUATED AND SOUGHT EMPLOYMENT FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO 13 THE 14 OF APPLICATION; (E) BEEN UNSUCCESSFUL IN OBTAINING FULL-TIME DATE EMPLOYMENT; (F) PROVIDED DOCUMENTATION THAT SUCH APPLICANT 15 HAS SOUGHT 16 EMPLOYMENT FOR SUCH A JOB IN NEW YORK STATE; AND (G) APPLIED FOR THE DEGREE ENHANCEMENT FOR EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM WITHIN ONE YEAR AFTER THE DATE 17 18 OF GRADUATION.

19 3. THE TRUSTEES OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK SHALL ESTABLISH OR 20 IDENTIFY EXISTING CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS THAT PROVIDE SKILLS FOR COLLEGE 21 GRADUATES TO ENHANCE THEIR EMPLOYMENT MARKETABILITY THAT ARE TAILORED TO 22 WHICH SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL ELIGIBLE APPLI-JOB MARKET NEEDS CANTS FREE OF CHARGE TO SUCH APPLICANT. THE 23 TRUSTEES SHALL PROMULGATE IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO 24 AND REGULATIONS RULES 25 ENSURE SUCH PROGRAMS ARE ALIGNED WITH JOB MARKET AND INDUSTRY NEEDS. IF 26 THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK DOES NOT CURRENTLY OFFER CERTIFICATE 27 PROGRAMS THAT MEET THE REOUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, OR IF CURRENT CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS ARE AT CAPACITY OR CAN NOT BE EXPANDED TO ADMIT ALL 28

1 ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS, SUCH PROGRAMS MAY BE OFFERED IN AN ON-LINE FORMAT 2 TO SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

3 IF THE COLLEGE FROM WHICH THE APPLICANT GRADUATED CURRENTLY OFFERS 4. 4 A CERTIFICATE PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SUBDIVI-SION THREE OF THIS SECTION, THEN IT SHALL BE THE CHOICE OF THE APPLICANT 5 6 EITHER ATTEND SUCH PROGRAM AT THAT CAMPUS OR COMPLETE SUCH PROGRAM ТΟ 7 ON-LINE; OR IF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS CURRENTLY OFFERING A CERTIFICATE 8 PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS IN SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION, SUCH APPLICANT SHALL HAVE THE CHOICE OF OBTAINING SUCH CERTIF-9 10 ICATE FROM SUCH COMMUNITY COLLEGE FREE OF CHARGE TO THE APPLICANT. SUCH COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE COST 11 OF SUCH APPLICANT'S ATTENDANCE IN THE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FROM THE STATE 12 UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK FOUR YEAR INSTITUTION FROM WHICH THE APPLICANT 13 14 RECEIVED HIS OR HER BACHELOR'S DEGREE.

5. EACH STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK INSTITUTION THAT CONFERS FOUR
YEAR DEGREES SHALL INFORM ALL INCOMING FRESHMAN AND TRANSFER STUDENTS
ABOUT ANTICIPATED JOB AVAILABILITY PER EACH MAJOR AND APPROXIMATE SALARY
RANGES PER EACH MAJOR, WHICH DEGREES WILL TYPICALLY REQUIRE A GRADUATE
DEGREE OR ADDITIONAL EDUCATION BEYOND A BACHELOR'S DEGREE AND ABOUT SUCH
INSTITUTION'S UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT EMPLOYMENT RATES MEASURED WITHIN ONE
YEAR OF SUCH STUDENTS' GRADUATION.

22 S 2. Section 6206 of the education law is amended by adding a new 23 subdivision 19 to read as follows:

19. A. THE "HELP INDIVIDUALS REACH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM" (HIRE) IS HERE-BY ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SKILLS FOR COLLEGE GRADUATES TO INCREASE THEIR EMPLOYMENT MARKETABILITY AND ATTAIN SUCCESSFUL JOB PLACE-MENT.

28 B. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HIRE PROGRAM, AN APPLICANT 29 SHALL HAVE: (I) RECEIVED AN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE FROM THE CITY UNIVERSI-TY OF NEW YORK AND HAVE ACHIEVED A GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF 3.0 OR HIGHER; 30 (II) COMPLETED THEIR DEGREE IN NO MORE THAN FIVE YEARS, OR SIX YEARS IF 31 32 THE DEGREE TYPICALLY REQUIRES FIVE YEARS; (III) COMPLETED AN APPROVED 33 EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING ACTIVITY, AS DEFINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; (IV) GRADUATED AND SOUGHT EMPLOYMENT FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO 34 35 DATE OF APPLICATION; (V) BEEN UNSUCCESSFUL IN OBTAINING FULL-TIME THE EMPLOYMENT; (VI) PROVIDED DOCUMENTATION THAT SUCH APPLICANT HAS 36 SOUGHT 37 EMPLOYMENT FOR SUCH A JOB IN NEW YORK STATE; AND (VII) APPLIED FOR THE 38 DEGREE ENHANCEMENT FOR EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM WITHIN ONE YEAR AFTER THE DATE 39 OF GRADUATION.

40 C. THE TRUSTEES OF THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK SHALL ESTABLISH OR IDENTIFY EXISTING CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS THAT PROVIDE SKILLS FOR COLLEGE 41 GRADUATES TO ENHANCE THEIR EMPLOYMENT MARKETABILITY THAT ARE TAILORED TO 42 43 JOB MARKET NEEDS, WHICH SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL ELIGIBLE APPLI-44 CANTS FREE OF CHARGE TO SUCH APPLICANT. THE TRUSTEES SHALL PROMULGATE 45 RULES AND REGULATIONS IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO ENSURE SUCH PROGRAMS ARE ALIGNED WITH JOB MARKET AND INDUSTRY NEEDS. IF 46 47 THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK DOES NOT CURRENTLY OFFER CERTIFICATE 48 PROGRAMS THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBDIVISION, OR IF CURRENT 49 CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS ARE AT CAPACITY OR CANNOT BE EXPANDED TO ADMIT ALL 50 ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS, SUCH PROGRAMS MAY BE OFFERED IN AN ON-LINE FORMAT TO SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBDIVISION. 51

D. IF THE COLLEGE FROM WHICH THE APPLICANT GRADUATED CURRENTLY OFFERS A CERTIFICATE PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS IN PARAGRAPH C OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THEN IT SHALL BE THE CHOICE OF THE APPLICANT TO EITHER ATTEND SUCH PROGRAM AT THAT CAMPUS OR COMPLETE SUCH PROGRAM ON-LINE; OR IF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS CURRENTLY OFFERING A CERTIFICATE PROGRAM THAT 1 MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS IN PARAGRAPH C OF THIS SUBDIVISION, SUCH APPLI-2 CANT SHALL HAVE THE CHOICE OF OBTAINING SUCH CERTIFICATE FROM SUCH 3 COMMUNITY COLLEGE FREE OF CHARGE TO THE APPLICANT. SUCH COMMUNITY 4 COLLEGE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE COST OF SUCH APPLI-5 CANT'S ATTENDANCE IN THE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FROM THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF 6 NEW YORK FOUR YEAR INSTITUTION FROM WHICH THE APPLICANT RECEIVED HIS OR 7 HER BACHELOR'S DEGREE.

8 E. EACH CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK INSTITUTION THAT CONFERS FOUR YEAR 9 DEGREES SHALL INFORM ALL INCOMING FRESHMEN AND TRANSFER STUDENTS ABOUT 10 ANTICIPATED JOB AVAILABILITY PER EACH MAJOR AND APPROXIMATE SALARY RANG-11 ES PER EACH MAJOR, WHICH DEGREES WILL TYPICALLY REQUIRE A GRADUATE 12 DEGREE OR ADDITIONAL EDUCATION BEYOND A BACHELOR'S DEGREE AND ABOUT SUCH 13 INSTITUTION'S UNDER GRADUATE STUDENT EMPLOYMENT RATES MEASURED WITHIN 14 ONE YEAR OF SUCH STUDENTS' GRADUATION.

15 S 3. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a 16 law.
